With the support of SVMA, CAJ launched the CAJ Regional Manufacturing Training Program in 2020. The program provides students with the basic skills for many entry-level manufacturing jobs. Recent grads are now employed by Siemens Mobility, Insight Manufacturing Services, and GNB Valves.

The CAJ Advanced Manufacturing Program currently offers curriculum in forklift driving & certification, warehouse management, OSHA 10 certification, electro-mechanical assembly, quality control, machining (CNC & manual), welding and manufacturing technician.

Forklift is offered as a one-day stand-alone class while the machining, welding, and manufacturing programs are offered as an 8-month program with 4 start dates annually.


